Organization Description

The National Native Commercial Tobacco Abuse Prevention Network was established in the spring of 2008 in an effort to create a true collaborative-interlocking system of stakeholders within American Indian and Alaska Native communities. The National Network is intimately connected to the communities they serve and bring a wealth of knowledge of culturally appropriate approaches for tobacco control. The National Network management is currently composed of the Intertribal Council of Michigan (ITCM), Muscogee Creek Nation (MCN), and the Health Education and Promotion Council (HEAPC). The core funding for the National Network comes through a cooperative agreement with Centers for Disease Control and Prevention— Office of Smoking and Health (agreement # 1U58DP001519-01), which is administered by the Inter-Tribal Council of Michigan.
